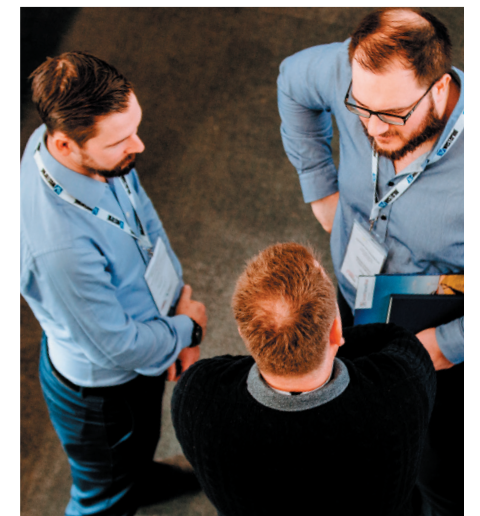
Our pricing is set to provide SMEs, micro-companies and universities with the same opportunity to gain access to the rail market normally enjoyed by much larger companies.

The exhibitor price is set at an exceptionally low price to reflect our continued aim to promote the growth of those participating in all areas of the rail market.

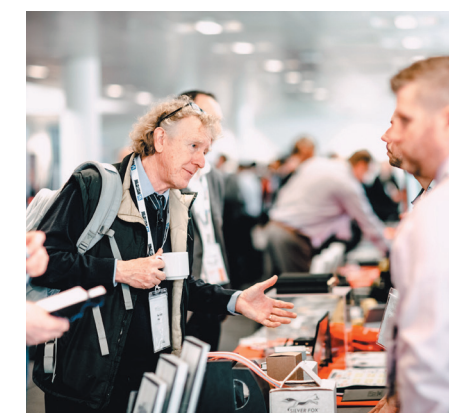
